

Whole School No-Smoking Policy

Policy Statement:

The entire Cranford School site is a no-smoking area. This includes outside areas, play areas and car parking areas. 'Smoking' for the purposes of this policy includes vaping as well as conventional cigarette or cigar smoking.

This policy has regard to the 'Statutory Framework for the Early Years Foundation Stage' (September 2022) Safeguarding and Welfare Requirement: (3.57 Safety and suitability of premises, environment and equipment: 'Providers must not allow smoking in or on the premises when children are present or about to be present.')

This policy is available in the Cranford School Policies section of the Whole School Staff Teams area on Microsoft Teams for all staff to read It is also available to parents and interested parties on the School website. It is reviewed annually, and when events or legislation requires, by the Headmaster. The next review date is November 2023.
